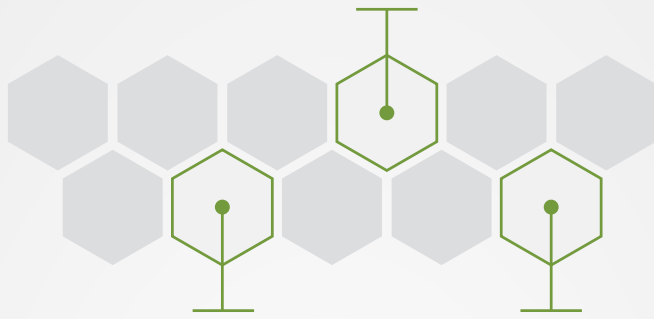
The Aga Khan Foundation undertook a study to address the needs of seniors in Portugal in 2009, conducted by CEDRU in collaboration with the Boston Consulting Group (BCG), followed by a mapping in 2015 to explore and validate medium - to long-term interests, talents and solutions for improving the quality of life of seniors.

This approach led to three interdependent and convergent pillars: Participation and Representation, Valuing seniors as an essential resource in society, and Strengthening of Formal and Informal Networks, including caregivers.

The objective is to place seniors at the centre of action and local decision-making processes, in order to recognise their value, knowledge and experience, articulate resources and foster collaborative work between people, and institutions from both the public and private sectors.

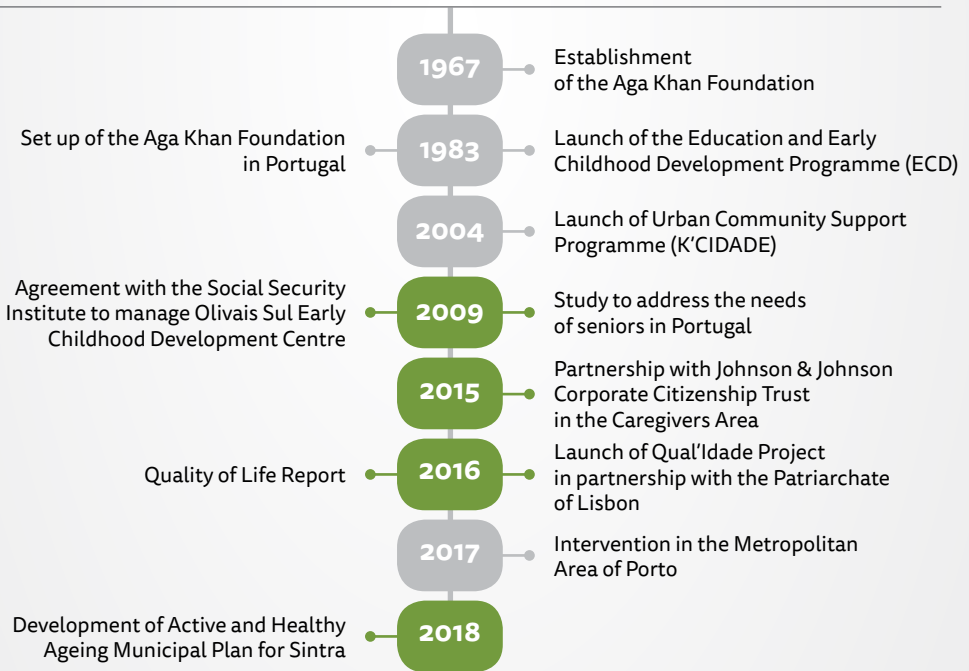
